



## Feuilles

**Yarn:** Briar Rose Fibers Grandma's Blessing or 350 yards of any sport weight yarn

**Needles:** US size 6

**Gauge:** Not important

**Finished Measurements (blocked):** 80" x 6"

### Pattern:

- Using Lucy Neatby's invisible cast on, CO 34 sts.
- Row 1 – Sl1 st with yarn in back. K33.
- Row 2 – Sl1 st with yarn in front. K32, P1.
- Repeat Rows 1 and 2 twice more (3 garter ridges)
- Begin Leaf Chart, being sure to slip the first stitch of every row as indicated.
- Work in pattern until scarf is 8" less than desired length.
- Row 1 – Sl1 st with yarn in back. K33.
- Row 2 – Sl1 st with yarn in front. K32, P1.
- Repeat Rows 1 and 2 twice more (3 garter ridges)
- Work End Lace Chart twice.
- Row 1 – Sl1 st with yarn in back. K33.
- Row 2 – Sl1 st with yarn in front. K32, P1.
- Repeat Rows 1 and 2 twice more (3 garter ridges)
- BO loosely.
- Place cast on sts on needle and remove waste yarn. Work End Lace Chart once.
- Row 1 – Sl1 st with yarn in back. K33.
- Row 2 – Sl1 st with yarn in front. K32, P1.
- Repeat Rows 1 and 2 twice more (3 garter ridges)
- BO loosely.
- Block to desired size and shape.

**Notes:** Repeat the section of the Leaf Chart between the bold lines (| |) twice in each row. Although the two purl stitches in the repeated section do not line up visually, they will line up in your knitting.

### Legend:

**slip**  
 RS: Slip stitch as if to purl, holding yarn in back  
 WS: Slip stitch as if to purl, holding yarn in front



**knit**  
 RS: knit stitch  
 WS: purl stitch



**purl**  
 RS: purl stitch  
 WS: knit stitch



**yo**  
 RS: Yarn Over  
 WS: Yarn Over



**No Stitch**  
 RS: Placeholder - No stitch made.  
 WS: none defined



**ssk**  
 RS: Slip one stitch as if to knit, Slip another stitch as if to knit. Insert left-hand needle into front of these 2 stitches and knit them together  
 WS: Purl two stitches together in back loops, inserting needle from the left, behind and into the backs of the 2nd & 1st stitches in that order



**k2tog**  
 RS: Knit two stitches together as one stitch  
 WS: Purl 2 stitches together



**sl1 k2tog psso**  
 RS: slip 1, k2tog, pass slip stitch over k2tog  
 WS: none defined



**M** Make one
